Dear Parents, Carers and Friends,

Attendance Update

Our attendance as of today is 93.9%, around 1% below national averages. While this may not seem a big difference, every single day in school plays an important part in children's learning, progress, and wellbeing. Children should stay home with a high temperature, vomiting, diarrhoea, or if they are too unwell to manage the day; however, most minor coughs and colds are absolutely fine for school. If you're unsure, please get in touch and we will be happy to advise.

Attendance letters went home today, please check bags. We also celebrated pupils with excellent attendance (over 99%) and those who have made significant improvements in our star assembly today. A big well done to all of them and they will receive a reward from myself in the new term!

Should I keep my **child off school?**



Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

but make sure you let their school or nursery know about...

Hand, foot and mouth	Glandular fever
Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the very sad news of two recent deaths in Kent linked to meningitis (strain B), we wanted to share some helpful information about meningococcal disease and the vaccinations available to protect against it.

Meningitis is a serious illness that affects the brain and spine. It is usually caused by an infection, such as Meningococcal disease. It can make someone very unwell very quickly. Signs can include a high temperature, headache, vomiting, stiff neck and feeling very sleepy.

Meningitis can affect anyone, but young children and teenagers are at higher risk.

It is important to get medical help straight away if you are worried.

- Many routine vaccinations protect against meningitis including MenB, DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB, PCV, MMRV and Men ACWY vaccines

The MenB vaccine was introduced in 2016 and is now routinely offered to babies at:

- 8 weeks
- 12 weeks
- 1 year

The MenB vaccine is not routinely offered to children over 2 years of age. Children born before 2016 would not have received this vaccine as part of the NHS schedule. It is however available privately.
