Acorns Class Reception & Year 1

Acorns have been learning about fruits and vegetables, discovering that fruits contain seeds – and were amazed to find out that tomatoes are actually fruits! They explored where different fruits and vegetables grow, identified which part of the plant we eat, practised safe cutting skills using a knife and fork, tasted a variety of fruits and juices, and finished the topic by making delicious smoothies using strawberries, peaches, kiwis, bananas and orange juice.

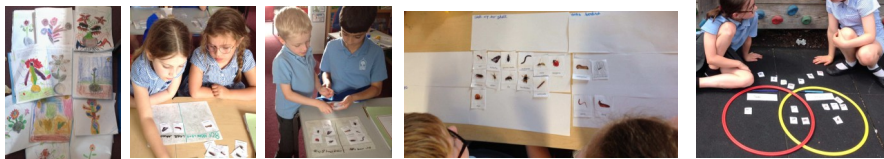
In Science, Acorns investigated whether the tallest trees have the widest trunks. After making predictions, they visited Forest School to measure different trees using string to compare trunk circumference and height. Working collaboratively, they found evidence to support their prediction and discussed whether this is always true. Over the summer holidays, they have been challenged to look out for any trees that don't fit this pattern!



Horse Chestnut Class Year 2, 3 & 4

The children have been working hard on their drawing skills in Art by observing carefully and practising shading techniques. As a result, they have produced wonderful pencil drawings of onions and then used their imaginations to add different lines and marks to show details in colour. Sycamore Class Year 5 & 6

It has been a busy couple of weeks for Sycamore and surviving the heat has added its own challenges! The class have really demonstrated their maturity though and coped well with the changes in timetable and temperature. We have been loving our class novel - The Invention of Hugo Cabret - and the children have been doing an excellent job studying one of the oldest silent movies ever made (Trip to the Moon by George Melies made in 1902), and they have written some wonderful film reviews about it. This week, we started some revision in maths time; going over some of the more tricky aspects of the subject that the children will need to use in

everyday life. They enjoyed dressing up as Rockstars for Numeracy Day as they were revising. Of course, the highlight of the last couple of weeks was the school trip to Stratford. Despite the threatening rain, the day was not a wash out and the children showed exemplary behaviour and enthusiasm throughout the day. Well done everyone and remember - in the words of the great Baz Luhrmann -

Should I keep my **child off school?**

Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

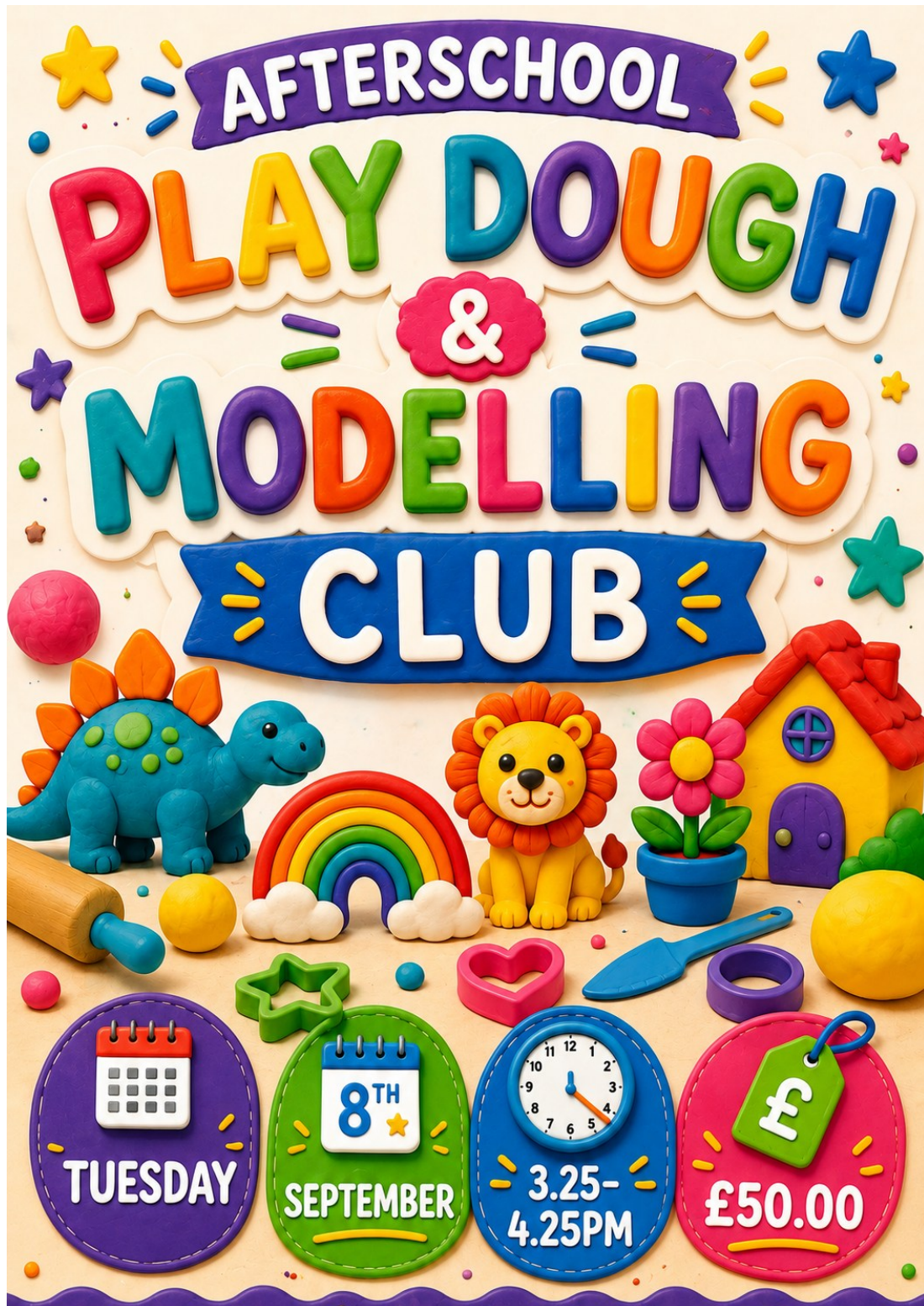

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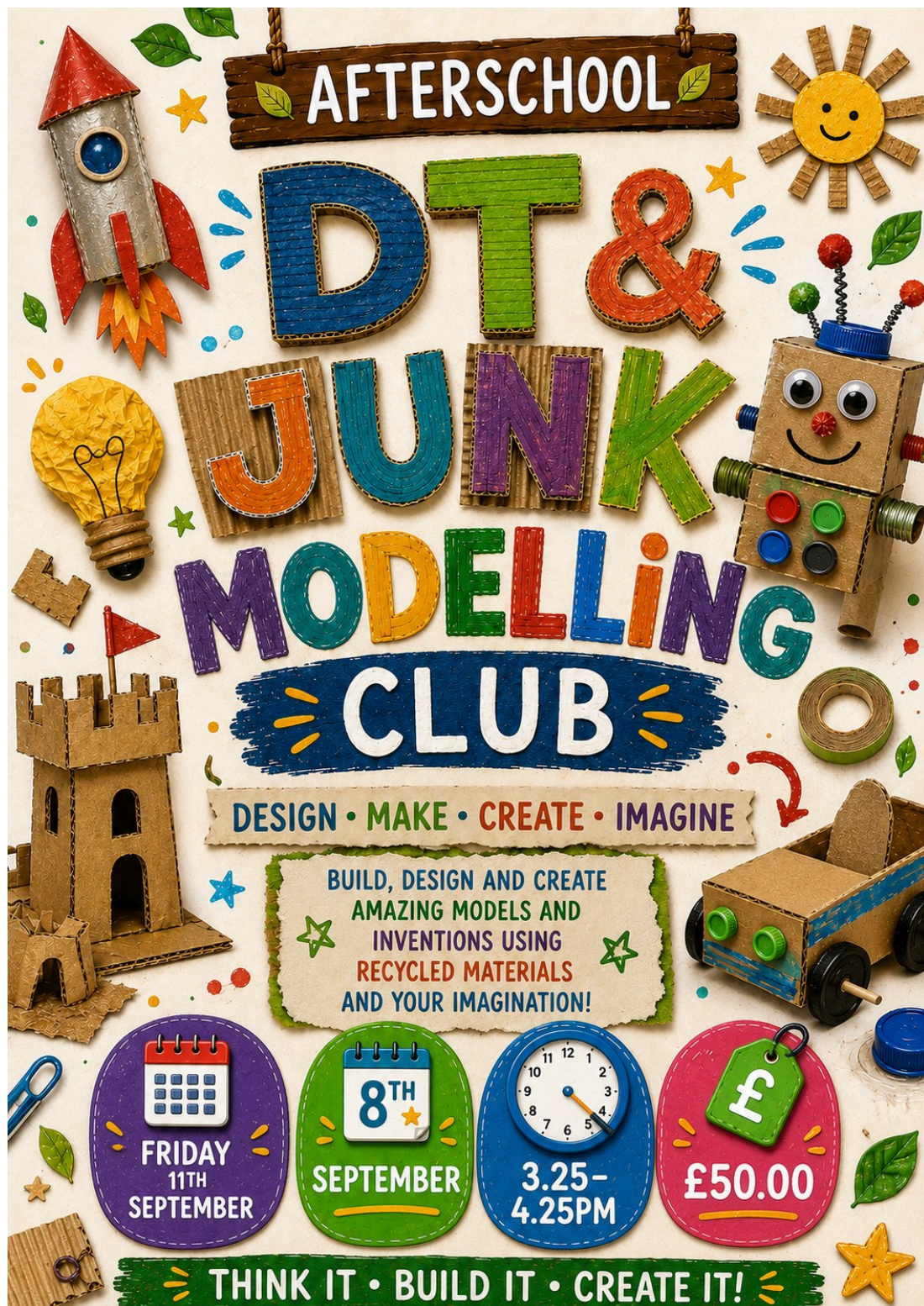

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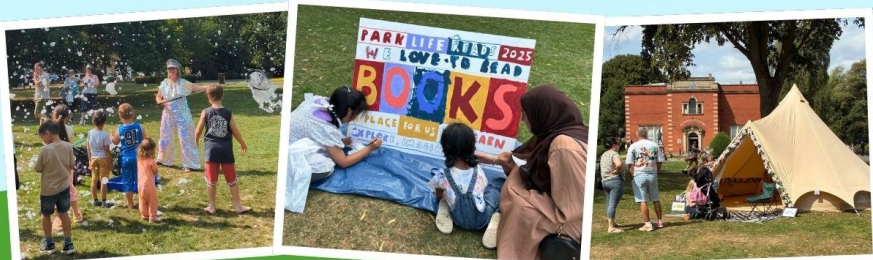

Holiday Activities & Food (HAF)

Dear Parent/Carer,

The DfE-funded HAF (Holiday Activities & Food) programme provides young people the opportunity to access enriching activities alongside healthy meals over the **main school holidays at Easter, Summer and Christmas.**

Please note that this programme is entirely separate from the Local Welfare Scheme's household support funding (i.e. supermarket HUGGG vouchers).

All young people who currently meet the following two criteria are eligible:

- In full-time education between Reception - Year 11
- Receiving benefits-related free school meals

Each eligible young person can access a maximum of **16 sessions** over the Summer holidays. Families have the flexibility to book with multiple activity providers if desired. All activity providers can request additional funding for 1:1 support if this is required, however this will depend on their staff availability and qualifications. We also fund a number of SEND-specific activities.

Please note you will need a HAF code to book activities. **Eligible families can access their HAF code through the 'Request a HAF code' form at www.warwickshire.gov.uk/haf.**

Summer activity listings will be live on our site from **Monday the 22nd of June** so that you can book. Activities will then begin from **Monday 20th July.**

Baby Massage: 5 week programme teaching parents the skills of massage which has many benefits for baby & helps to create a close bond, suitable for babies after they've had their 6 to 8 weeks check

Children's Activity Club: aimed at children aged 4-8 years, different activities each week which may include - improving your crafting skills, games, construction

Outdoor Messy Play: outdoor play activities for children with their parents, including sand, mud, painting

Baby & Toddler Chatter Matters: 5 week courses of fun through songs, rhymes and sensory activities for babies and toddlers to support their early communication skills. Suitable from 5 months up to 3 years

HomeEd Group: play activities for children with their parents who are planning to Home Educate

Let's Play/Stay & Play & Toddler Time: These sessions are aimed at toddlers, offering language enrichment learning through play. They incorporate paint and print, messy play, sound and music and outdoor play

SEND Little Stars (0-5yrs): Small, friendly groups to support learning and play for children with additional needs. Children must have a diagnosis or be in the process of being diagnosed. A great opportunity to interact and meet other families

Wellcomm screens: A speech & language toolkit which can pinpoint areas in your child's speech which can be enhanced with targeted activities to help your child speak clearly and with confidence
