Worship that is ... Inclusive, invitational and inspiring

Collective worship in Church of England schools must recognise the collectively of all participants, so must not assume, that all have the same beliefs and values. All acts of worship must therefore be, inclusive, invitational and inspiring.

In a Church of England school, collective worship is:

- ' **Invitational**, offering everyone the opportunity to engage in the act of worship, whilst allowing the freedom for those of other faiths and none to be present with integrity.
- ' **Inspiring** and creative, impacting the whole community and motivating them into action.
- ' **Inclusive**, where all are included, have a voice and are listened to.
- ' A **valued** part of the culture of the school, breathing life into every aspect of the school day.

Collective worship gives pupils and school staff the opportunity to:

- Engage in an act of community.
- Express praise and thanksgiving to God.
- Be still and reflect.
- Explore the big questions of life and respond to national events.
- Foster respect and deepen spiritual awareness.
- Reflect on the character of God and on the teachings of Christ.
- Affirm Christian values and attitudes.
- Share each other's joys and challenges.
- Celebrate special times in the Christian calendar.
