Monday	Whole-school Collective Worship, followed by class-based worship led by pupils with adult support.
Values cycle	Community -> Trust -> Hope -> Forgiveness -> Perseverance -> Respect, then repeating through the year.
Festivals	Harvest, Christmas and Easter have dedicated acts of worship. The values cycle pauses and then continues. Each value is revisited through a different story, teaching or practical application so understanding deepens over time.
